## place

The Wichita Workcamp will be hosted at the Northside church of Christ in Wichita, Kansas.

## worksite

A worksite is a home that needs painting. This may include scraping, caulking, minor repairs, cleanup, or yard work.

## safety issues

Safety is a priority at Wichita Workcamp. As such, we require all workers to sign release forms in case of emergency and provide proof of health insurance. All work will be supervised and reasonable precautions will be made to ensure the safety of all workers. Churches are required to send one adult for every five teenagers. Students must have completed the seventh grade to participate. Water and lunch breaks as well as first aid kits are provided for each crew.

## dress code

Going into the community, we are being ambassadors for Christ. Please dress modestly. During the day long shorts (at the knee) and T-shirts are fine. You will get paint on your clothes.

**Girls:** Do not bring revealing tank tops or short shorts. No undergarments showing.

**Guys:** You must wear a shirt at all times. Do not cut away the sides and turn it into a cape.

Everyone will have a chance to go home and change each afternoon so bring modest, casual clothes for the evening sessions.

## things to bring

Work clothes (you don't mind getting dirty); casual clothes for afternoon recreation and evening devotional; a good paint brush (3-5" in size); Bible; hat; sunglasses; water bottle; sunscreen; work gloves; sack lunch (unless you're from out of town; out-of-town guests have lunch provided by host homes); toiletries.

## nighttime

During each night of Workcamp, all campers come together for a meal, followed by singing and a devotional speaker. Additionally, we will have time for groups to meet together to share their experiences of that day's events.
